- Regularly rehearse with vocal teams, worship bands, & AV teams.
- Coordinate & lead the creative process for all camps/retreats/special events.

- Oversee & implement strategic vision for the discipleship ministry to students, particularly female students, that encapsulates relational discipleship in all areas, in partnership with the vision, support, & coaching of the Youth Ministry Leader.
- Develop & work directly with existing ministry leaders & volunteers in all areas providing support, development & leadership as needed.
- Actively lead, recruit for & organize Youth Ministry activities & programming.
- Attend & assist in planning & executing special programs & events such as VBS, Winter Camp, retreats, Confirmation, mission trips, service projects, etc.
- Develop appropriate discipleship relationships with students.
- Teach & lead Middle School Sunday Nights, High School Midweeks, & Confirmation as assigned by the Youth Ministry Leader.
- Lead a Female Middle School Small Group through the school year.
- Attend conferences, networking events, etc. at the discretion of the Youth Ministry Leader.
- Attend student events.

- Make St. Andrew's Church - Mt. Pleasant your home church.
- Other duties as assigned by the Youth Ministry Leader.
- Assist with administrative duties as assigned.
